

Created in March 1995 as the Department of Indian System of Medicine and Homeopathy (ISM&H) under the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, it was renamed as the Department of Ayurveda, Yoga and Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha and Homoeopathy (AYUSH) in November 2003. On 9th November, 2014, the Department of AYUSH has been upgraded to Ministry of AYUSH to ensure the optimal development and propogation of Indian systems of healthcare.

The Ministry of AYUSH envisions to position AYUSH systems as the preferred systems of living and practice for attaining a healthy India. It aims to upgrade the standards of colleges and strengthen research institutions. It draws up schemes for promotion, cultivation and regeneration of medicinal plants used in AYUSH systems. The Ministry also deals with the development of pharmacopoeial standards for AYUSH drugs.
