For and on behalf of the Research Officer, In-Charge, RRIUM, Chennai sealed tenders are invited from reputed & interested suppliers duly registered with the Goods and Service Tax Authority for supplying of RAW DRUGS AND MATERIALS for manufacturing of Unani Formulations as mentioned in the list (Annexure –I).
- 2. All offers should be made in two parts viz. Technical and Price Bids.
- 3. The contract that may eventuate from the tender will be governed by the conditions detailed herein. If you are in a position to quote for supply as per the schedule to the tender form attached here to, you may please submit the quotations/ bids on the said Tender form format as per instructions contained therein. All offers should be made in English.
- 4. Each copy of the tender should be a complete document and should preferably be bound as a volume.
- 5. Suppliers / Parties must submit tender in two separate envelops duly sealed marking as Envelop No. 1 and Envelop No. 2 and containing free samples of raw drugs and materials 100 grams each except Mastagi 5 g, SalabMisri 25 g,Ood-i-Saleeb 25 g & Zafran 2 g should be packed in properly labeled packets and packed in a sealed box.  - iii. If at any stage, any of the information declaration given by the bidder is found to be false.
